A great way to explore the beautiful coastline is to use the Coastliner bus service which normally runs throughout the year between King's Lynn, Hunstanton and Cromer.

By bike, National Cycle Route 1 runs through West Norfolk via King's Lynn, Sandringham and Burnham Market, whilst Route 11 runs from Cambridge through Downham Market to connect with Route 1 south of King's Lynn.
